BACA has a central contact person to receive calls from referring agencies and individuals. If a recognized, authorized agency with which the child has had contact determines that a child is frightened by his or her environment, the liaison contacts the family and an initial ride is organized to meet the child at their home or in some other location. The entire BACA chapter rides to meet the child and he/she is given a vest with a BACA patch sewn on the back. The child is free to wear the vest or not, and we support their decision. Following the initial contact, the child is given the name and number of two BACA members residing geographically closest to them.

BACA is a support group for the child and the family. BACA members never go to the child's house alone and never without the knowledge or permission of the parents. All BACA members must pass an extensive background check. Our mission is to help the children and their families learn how powerful they can be.
